1:30 P.M.: The above-entitled action is called for hearing of two motions for protective order, filed by defendants, Micron Technology and Hynix Semiconductor, respectively, and for a case management conference. Court and counsel are present as listed above. The Court issues a tentative ruling. The motions for protective order are argued. A request by both sides for supplemental briefing (regarding “gag” orders) is granted. Supplemental briefs shall be filed on or before April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2006. Final responsive briefs shall be filed no later than April 25, 2006. Ruling on the motions for protective order shall then stand submitted as of April 26, 2006. In event the motions for protective order are denied, plaintiffs must treat the relevant documents as if covered by the previously filed stipulated protective order for 20 days after the date of the order denying further protective order. However, during that period plaintiffs may show the documents to its clients, Rambus board, provided each individual viewer first agrees to be bound by the terms of the protective order. A Declaration of Shont E. Williams, lodged conditionally under seal, is withdrawn and returned to the submitting party in open court. .

A case management conference is held. Court and counsel confer regarding further proceedings. The plaintiffs may serve certain discovery as reflected in the notes of the court reporter. This action is continued to May 30, 2006, at 2:30 p.m., for further case management conference. Counsel may request a continuance if they are engaged in trial in another court.
